

Employment Horizons begins expansion

CEDAR KNOLLS — State Senate President **Richard Codey** and state Sen. **Anthony Bucco** (R-Morris) were among the dignitaries who turned out last week for the groundbreaking of a new expansion at **Employment Horizons**, a nonprofit agency that provides employment services to more 550 individuals with disabilities annually. The 22,000-square-foot addition to the agency's existing building will serve an increasing number of individuals with disabilities, expand existing programs, introduce new training units and create a larger warehouse capable of accepting additional business contracts.
